

## **Overview of functions (buttons described as for the pre-facelift 9-5):**

1) On startup, BLAUX shows its firmware version on SID. The device's status LED shows a „heartbeat“ signal when it's in operating state.

2) Up to 4 phones / tablets can be paired with BLAUX. If there's only one phone paired, it connects automatically as soon as it is in range of the BLAUX unit. Upon connection, the SID shows a message "[phone name] connected"; if the phone does not support the AVRCP profile (remote control), the SID shows "[phone name] connected, sound only".

All paired phones can be deleted from the BLAUX's memory by pressing "NIGHT PANEL" and "UP" SID buttons simultaneously.

**Note: it is recommended to delete the paired phones when you power up the BLAUX for the first time after installation.**

3) BLAUX becomes active when the head unit switches to CDC mode and if there's a phone connected to it; it automatically starts playback from the phone. Playback is paused if the head unit exits the CDC mode, is switched off, or the phone disconnects.

4) During playback, track info (artist, album, track name and number) can be shown on SID. Audio text can be enabled (it's disabled by default) by pressing the "CLR" button on the SID. Track info is shown in format "[artist], [album] - [track name]".

5) Next and previous tracks can be selected by using the steering wheel controls or buttons on the head unit. Track change may take up to a second, as the Bluetooth data stream does not react immediately.

6) The connected phone's volume setting must be kept as low as possible to avoid audio distortion. As a rule of thumb, the Bluetooth audio volume must match that of the head unit's FM radio.
